

# F.D.S. Disposal Recycling Program

- Aluminum beverage containers
- Tin Food Cans
- Glass food & beverage containers / Clear- Brown-Green
- PET / Plastic containers with the symbol #1 – narrow neck containers only
- HDPE / natural plastic containers with the symbol # 2 narrow neck containers only (Milk and water bottles)
- HDPE / pigmented plastic containers with the # 2 narrow neck containers (Detergent, shampoo, bleach)
- Plastics with the symbol #3, #4, #5, #6, #7 narrow and screw top containers only containers
- Newsprint
- Cardboard containers / Large boxes must be cut down to dimensions no larger than 3ft. X 3ft. Cereal, cracker and pizza boxes (without food & wax paper in boxes) are OK
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Telephone books
- Printer & copy paper
- Mail (junk)
- All other paper without wax liners
- Aseptic packaging (milk & juice containers)

## Materials NOT acceptable:

Hazardous Materials containers, of any type; including empty oil containers, pesticide containers, and paint containers, place these empty containers in with your regular garbage. Should you have any full containers of household hazardous waste for disposal? - Liquids & Food waste
- Microwave trays & Frozen food boxes
- Wax paper products
- Mirrors
- Window & Auto Glass
- Light Bulbs
- Ceramics
- Porcelain
- Plastic unnumbered / Grocery Bags, visqueen, trash bags, Styrofoam, PVC piping
- Coat hangers
- Glass cookware/ bake ware
- Household items such as cooking pots, toasters, electrical appliances
- Garden hoses
- Electric cords or Christmas Lights
- Or any other household items
